TO: Readers of Summerhaven Wind Energy Centre Application for a Renewable Energy Approval

RE: Summerhaven Site Plan Changes

Summerhaven Wind, LP (a wholly owned subsidiary of NextEra Energy Canada, ULC) is planning to engage in a renewable energy project in respect of which the issuance of a renewable energy approval is required. The Ministry of the Environment (MOE) has screened the submission according to the requirements set out in Regulation 359/09 and the application has been deemed complete. The MOE is now undertaking a technical review of the submission. Copies of the following documents supporting this application as filed with the MOE have been made available for review at the Haldimand County office in Cayuga at 45 Munsee Street North and electronically on the website http://www.CanadianWindProposals.com.

Minor project location changes have been proposed since the time of the application on June 14, 2011. These changes are described in the REA Submission Design Change Report dated August 2011. These changes include the removal of a proposed wind turbine location and the alteration of some turbine access roads and collection cable routes. The Noise Study Report (now dated August 2011) has also been updated to reflect these changes.

Please refer to the REA Submission Design Change Report in conjunction with reviewing the other documents as the information contained within supersedes the information contained within the other REA documentation.
