RE: Municipal Consultation for the Summerhaven Wind Energy Centre proposed by NextEra Energy Canada, ULC and Air Energy TCI Inc.

**OBJECTIVE:** To obtain Council's endorsement of staff recommendations for the Municipal Consultation portion of the Provincial Renewable Energy Approval process as it pertains to the Summerhaven Wind Energy Centre as proposed by NextEra Energy Canada, ULC and Air Energy TCI Inc.

#### **RECOMMENDATIONS:**

- 1. THAT Report PED-EDT-05-2011 Re: Municipal Consultation for the Summerhaven Wind Energy Centre proposed by NextEra Energy Canada, ULC and Air Energy TCI Inc. dated November 29, 2010 be received;
- 2. AND THAT Council endorses staff recommendations for the Municipal Consultation portion of the Renewable Energy Approval form for the Summerhaven Wind Energy Centre as proposed by NextEra Energy Canada, ULC and Air Energy TCI Inc;
- 3. AND THAT Council direct staff to submit these recommendations to NextEra Energy Canada, ULC and Air Energy TCI Inc., so that these comments are included in their documentation to be sent to the provincial approval body.

4. AND THAT Council direct staff to advise NextEra Energy Canada, ULC and Air Energy TCI Inc. that Haldimand County will require compensation, to be negotiated, in return for the use of County Roads for the collection and transmission infrastructure of electricity generated by the proposed project through an "Road Allowance Use Agreement".

#### BACKGROUND:

In Fall 2009, Ontario's Green Energy and Green Economy Act was enacted. The purpose of this act is to facilitate renewable energy projects across the Province. In developing provincial standards such as standardized setback requirements and a streamlined approval process; it is intended to place Ontario as the North American leader in attracting renewable energy projects and green jobs.

The Ontario Green Energy and Green Economy Act approval process has integrated matters traditionally dealt with at the municipal level and established that only one approval permit from the Province is required. However, municipalities still play a role in terms of building permits and as a consultation agency. Proponents are required by regulation to circulate the consultation form to the Clerk of every municipality where a project is located. The Municipal Consultation Form will address matters relating to municipal or local infrastructure and servicing. Proponents must show how they address municipal or local authority concerns or why they were unable to do so. The scope of municipal consultation does not address the principle of the land use or the siting of energy production structures but does include:

- Proposed project area and property boundaries.
- Proposed road access location.
- Location and type of municipal service connections that may be required.
- Traffic management plans during construction and operation.
- Construction plans related to rehabilitation of temporary disturbance areas and any municipal infrastructure that may be damaged during construction.
- Emergency management procedures/safety protocols as specified in the Response plan.

A Haldimand County Renewable Energy Review Team comprised of staff from Economic Development and Tourism, Planning and Development, Engineering Services, Emergency Services, Building Controls & By-law Enforcement, Forestry Conservation, Haldimand County Hydro and the Conservation Authorities has been formed in response to the municipal consultation requirements put forward in the Green Energy and Green Economy Act. This review team referred to as the Haldimand County Renewable Energy Review Team (Review Team) has met regularly with representatives of NextEra Energy Canada, ULC and Air Energy TCI Inc., to provide insight and information as requested and offer a one-window service approach for renewable energy projects in Haldimand County to ensure that Haldimand County's concerns are being addressed.

#### ANALYSIS:

The Haldimand County Renewable Energy Review Team has held several meetings with the proponents to provide information and review the proposed Summerhaven Wind Energy Project. Following is a brief summary of the project, the components and location:

#### Summerhaven Wind Energy Centre

Project Overview – The goal of the Summerhaven Wind Energy Centre is to generate electricity from the wind using up to 61 wind turbines. Each turbine is designed to produce 2.21 megawatts (MW) of electricity. The nameplate capacity of the entire project, or the maximum amount of electricity that the wind turbines can produce is 135.5 MW.

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Project Components – up to 61 Wind Turbines; a substation; transmission lines that carry electricity to the Hydro One corridor; an operations and maintenance building located beside the substation; access roads that allow personnel and equipment to access turbines; underground and overhead cables will connect turbines to each other; 2 Weather towers will monitor wind speeds for project operation.

Project Location – The project study area includes 22, 583 hectares of private land and county road easements in Haldimand County as demonstrated by the map of the project area (Attachment 3 under separate cover). The project area includes approximately 2678 properties within Haldimand County.

Consulting with Municipalities – Municipal consultation is mandatory for all projects requiring a Renewable Energy Approval (REA). Consultation with the municipality (or municipalities) in which the facility would be located is required to take place at least 90 days before submitting the Renewable Energy Approval form to the province.

The Ministry of the Environment provides applicants with the Renewable Energy Approval (REA) form that outlines what is required to be addressed with municipal officials. The form requests municipal feedback on matters related to:

- Municipal services and infrastructure (such as the proposed road access).
- The rehabilitation of areas disturbed and/or municipal infrastructure damaged during construction.
- The Proposed Traffic Management Plans.
- Municipal or Local Authority Service Connections.
- Proposed landscaping design for the facility.
- Emergency management procedures/safety protocols.
- Building Code permits and licenses.
- Recommendations related to the identification of any significant natural features and water bodies within the municipality or territory and archaeological resource or heritage resource.

If the applicant is not able to provide all of the required information, the complete submission must explain why. In addition, the applicant must describe and document efforts to address any issues raised during municipal consultation.

Prior to the submission of Report PED-EDT-05-2011 to Council, the following steps have been taken to ensure adequate consultation between Haldimand County and the project proponents:

- 1. Since early 2009, several meetings have been held with NextEra Energy Canada, ULC and Air Energy TCI Inc., to discuss various aspects of the Summerhaven Wind Energy Centre project.
- The Haldimand County Renewable Energy Review team has thoroughly reviewed all draft documents as provided by NextEra Energy Canada, ULC and Air Energy TCI Inc.
   Comments and feedback from the Review Team have been included in the completed Renewable Energy Approval Consultation Form; municipalities, local authorities.
- 3. On November 16, 2010, the Haldimand County Renewable Energy Review Team met with NextEra Energy Canada, ULC and Air Energy TCI Inc. representatives and provided detailed feedback on the project with respect to the municipal consultation portion of the Renewable Energy Approval Form. The project representatives were

advised at that time that the Review Team would be seeking Council's endorsement of the information included in the attached Renewable Energy Approval Form.

Full comments from the Review Team are found as in Attachment 2 to this report. Following are the key comments that were raised at the meeting on November 16, 2010 and are included in the attached document.

- 1. Turbine # 2 is currently located within the urban boundary of Jarvis and needs to be relocated. This turbine has since been removed from the proponent's plans. Further, Haldimand County requests that all turbines located near Jarvis are reviewed to determine appropriate setbacks from urban boundaries.
- 2. Turbine # 5, 7, 8, and 57 share a very long access road. Haldimand County requests an additional access road in the event of an emergency.
- 3. Haldimand County Review Team will need to review road entrances and access roads when final design completed. Also, where two or more road accesses will abut the same road, intersection details will be required. Haldimand County will be reviewing structures on access roads, and ensure adequate ?or crossings, bridges, culverts etc., when final design is forwarded.
- 4. Haldimand County requires a pre and post construction road condition survey. An appropriate agreement and a suitable security should be collected to ensure that the affected roads are restored to pre-construction condition.
- 5. The Review Team has stated that all required Haldimand County permits will not be granted until all requested documents and reports are submitted and approved by Haldimand County.
- 6. Entrance permits are required for all turbines with the exception of Turbine # 1 and # 3 as they are under Ministry of Transportation (MTO) jurisdiction and will require MTO permits. Entrance permits require detailed drawing as well as intersection details.
- 7. During the construction phase this project will be putting a fairly significant road system into our rural area. Haldimand County will require all access roads to be well signed as there is a concern that the public might perceive these as concession roads. Labeling of entrances will need to be addressed at the pre-construction phase.
- 8. The Traffic Management plan has not been provided to the Review Team. When it is provided, the Haldimand County Renewable Energy Review Team requests the ability to review and provide comments. The Traffic Management plan must be submitted prior to the Road Condition survey being completed.
- 9. Haldimand County has requested for review and comment the final design of the transmission line design.
- 10. An Emergency Management Procedure/Safety Protocols plan has not been provided to the Review Team. At which time it is provided the Review Team requests the ability to review and provide comments.
- 11. Building permits are required for the wind turbines and any substations greater than 10 square metres. Civic addresses will need to be created and signs placed at Haldimand County roads and access roads to towers. The towers will need to be additionally

labeled with the civic addresses especially when multiple towers are accessed via the same access road.

12. The County would like to receive additional information on the transportation route planned for transportation of the turbine parts into the County and if the proponent has observed the spring weight restrictions. The County wants to ensure that the proponent has adequately planned around the proposed reconstruction of the Cayuga bridge and if they have a determined route through Haldimand County.

In addition to the specific municipal comments required under the REA process during municipal consultation, Haldimand County Council raised concerns that were reflective of concerns raised by ratepayers in the County. These were forwarded to the proponents of all wind energy generation projects on August 24, 2010 via email. These concerns are listed below and have yet to be fully addressed:

- 1. Greater details relating to the cutting of woodlots and proposed measures for replacement of these environmental features. Also how other features including wetlands and significant species will be impacted/mitigated.
- 2. Evaluation of the possible impacts of the anchoring of wind turbines to bedrock and whether this provides a conduit for the transmission of vibration to other properties.
- 3. The relationship of the proposed electrical transmission corridors to the County's Trail Master Plan and opportunities/constraints that may exist or occur.
- 4. Clarification on the location of the transmission corridor.
- 5. Confirmation that the decommissioning plan, funding mechanisms and report will include the capital works in the transmission corridor.
- 6. The impact of construction traffic and access from the County Road system to the project components and how this will be addressed.
- 7. As part of the economic impact assessment conduct a complete comparison of the difference between the project and the use of the land for agricultural purposes to Haldimand County. Also provide a breakdown of the type of jobs to be created.

Since the above-mentioned Council comments were forwarded on August 24, 2010, additional concerns and issues have been raised by Council and the community that have been included in the municipal consultation form. These are as follows:

- 1. The impact this project will have on tourism.
- 2. The impact on the property values of land adjacent to the project.
- 3. Additional information and studies to show how the setback of wind turbines of 550 metres was determined.
- 4. A request for studies that demonstrate how high or low pitch frequencies affect the nervous and mobility system and the long term affects for human and animal health.

- 5. A request for the results of studies on how wildlife (birds, deer, fox, rabbit, wolf, mice, earthworms, insects etc.) are affected in the immediate and surrounding areas where wind turbines are already in place.
- 6. A request for confirmation that upon the termination of the wind turbine projects the land involved in the projects will revert back to agriculture land from industrial.
- 7. Demonstrated outcomes of the consultation with the First Nations on all renewable energy projects.

#### Collection and Transmission Lines Review

The Summerhaven Wind Energy Centre project, similar to the other two projects (Samsung Inc and Capital Power) being proposed within Haldimand County will require the use of County road allowances for the collection and transmission of electricity generated as a result of these private, for-profit energy projects. Haldimand County will require compensation for said use of County road allowances; the amount of which is to be negotiated and approved by Council prior to Haldimand County permitting works within County Road allowances through a "Road Allowance Use Agreement".

#### Further Consultation

It should be noted that in no way does the submission of the attached Municipal Consultation form constitute the completion of municipal involvement or approval of the Summerhaven Wind Energy Centre project. This is simply the end of the first phase of the development approval process and staff will continue working with the proponent on an on-going basis.

#### BUDGET/LEGAL IMPLICATIONS:

There are no budgetary implications resulting from the recommendations contained within Report PED-EDT-05-2011.

The approval process with respect to green energy generation projects, such as wind and solar, rests with the Province of Ontario. Municipal approval authority with respect to the principle of land use and setback requirements as traditionally authorized through the *Planning Act* were removed through the enactment of the Green Energy Act in 2009.

### INTERDEPARTMENTAL IMPACTS:

The formation of the Haldimand County Renewable Energy Review Team which includes representation of several divisions provides the expertise needed to confidently address the renewable energy projects as proposed for Haldimand County.

Please note once the Haldimand County Renewable Energy Review Team completes the <u>Renewable Energy Approval - Municipal consultation form</u> the process is to submit a report to Council seeking their approval of the comments included on the form.

The Summerhaven Wind Energy Centre project, being proposed within Haldimand County will require the use of County road allowances for the collection and transmission of electricity generated as a result of these private, for-profil energy projects. Haldimand County will require compensation for said use of County road allowances; the amount of which is to be negotiated and approved by Council prior to Haldimand County permitting works within County Road allowances.

It should be noted that in no way does the submission of the attached Municipal Consultation form constitute the completion of municipal involvement or approval of the Summerhaven Wind Energy Centre project. This is simply the end of the first phase of the development approval process and staff will look forward to continuing the positive professional working relationship between the company and the County.

In addition concerns were raised by Haldimand County Council and forwarded to the proponent via email on August 24, 2010. These concerns have yet to be fully addressed by the proponent. Haldimand County concerns are as follows:

1. Council has requested greater details relating to the cutting of woodlots and proposed measure for replacement of these environmental features. Also how other features including wetlands and significant species will be impacted/mitigated.

2. Evaluation of the possible impacts of the anchoring of wind turbines to bedrock and whether this provides a conduit for the transmission of vibration to other properties.

The relationship of the proposed electrical transmission corridors to the County's Trail Master Plan and opportunities/constraints that may exist of occur.

4. Clarification on the location of the transmission corridor.

Confirmation that the decommissioning plan, funding mechanism and report will include the capital works in the transmission corridor.

6. The impact of construction traffic and access from the County Road system to the project components and how this will be addressed.

7. As part of the economic impact assessment conduct a complete comparison of the difference between the project and the use of the land for agricultural purposes to Haldimand County. Also provide a breakdown of the type of jobs to be created.

In cases where trees may have to be removed to implement portions of the proposed wind energy project, appropriate compensation for trees to be removed should be provided. Haldimand County's Forestry Officer should be consulted to determine the appropriate plan/program for such.

Every effort should be made to limit;

- encroachment into adjacent woodlands,
  - including improper removal of overhanging branches which would impact the health of the adjacent trees;
  - resulting in destruction of trees and reducing forest cover;
- removal of trees located in windrows, fence rows, along natural features
- removal of single "public" trees within road allowances for the purpose of installing transmission lines – underground or above ground. Removal of trees adjacent/underneath utility corridors is preferred versus ongoing maintenance/pruning, in most cases.

In previous similar applications the proposed final draft of locations of towers, roads, utility lines was reviewed in the field by Forest Conservation Services staff before finalization of the project layout – staff would request the same.

Where such impacts were required, the "contractor" and County staff agreed upon compensation in lieu of destruction of trees.

Removal of woodlands would require compensation in lieu which would result in a "zero-net" loss of County forest cover – thus funding of reforestation on lands elsewhere in Haldimand County – either through the Haldimand & Area Woodlot Owners Association, the Long Point Region Conservation Authority, or the Grand River Conservation Authority.

As for removal of single road allowance tree(s), compensation would be tree for tree (minimum 40 mm calliper – native tree stock) – offering first right of refusal for a compensating tree being offered to impacted adjacent property owners. Surplus trees would be used to replant strategically along County roadsides.

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Haldimand County Review Team Comments

MOE has exempted Summerhaven Wind Energy Centre from submitting Stage 2 archaeological assessment prior to accepting their renewable energy approval (REA) application. Stages 2,3 and 4 archaeological assessments are now in process with consultants. Haldimand County would like to request that the findings of the archaeological assessments be shared and adequate mitigation measures be adopted where needed to minimize any adverse impacts. The archaeological assessment should be done in consultation with First Nations communities.

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
